- 1956-1963 Eight years of driving in International Rallyes and extensive Go-Karting in Europe.
Class winner and fifth overall in Int. Tulip Rallye in 1963.
- 1961-1962 Started racing on tracks in Dutch National Races at Zandvoort.....7 Races
- 1963 Racing in private cars with the NAV at Zandvoort..... 8 Races
- 1964 **Started his own Racing Team "Scuderia Auto Swart"** raced in FIA-Touring car
Challenge in Europe. Issued with International FIA License.19 Races
- 1965-1970 **Raced 5 years in the Abarth Factory team in European FIA Touring Car Challenge.**
Started the successful Dutch racing team "Team Radio Veronica" in 1967.
Won Three times the European FIA Touring Car Challenge Championship title
and 5 times The Dutch National Touring car Championship title.....114 Races
- 1969-1970 Raced in the FIA - Two Liter Sports/ Prototype Championship **won FIA Sports car**
Champion title in 1970 with Abarth 2000SP. Participated in the South America's
Argentine Temporada Series (two races) with Barry Smith from the UK in a Lola T70
- 1971- 1972 **Started "Canon Racing Team"** and raced in FIA Sports/Prototype races in Europe
with Chevron B19 (co-driver was John Burton from the UK)
Participated in Springbok Series in South Africa with Jody Scheckter as co-driver.
Finished 2nd Overall behind Brian Redman.21 Races.
- 1972 Retired from pro-racing due to business commitments
- 1974-1981 Clerk of the Course / Chief Steward (Race Director) for the Dutch F1 Grand Prix races and all**
the National and International races at Zandvoort, the Netherlands, for 8 years.
- 1976-1980 Re-start in Historic races in Europe with Ferrari 250 SWB and 250 LM.16 Races.
- 1981-1985 Historic races and IMSA Prototype races in USA.11 Races.
- 1985-1997 **Joined the Vintage Auto Racing Association as a Board member, President for two years. (1995-1996).**
- 1986-1990 Historic races in Europe and USA. 58 Races.
- 1991-1996 Historic races in Europe with Ferrari 512 BBLM and **35 races in Super Sport Cup Series.**
with Chevron B19. In the USA with Sports /Proto-type cars, Formula 2 and Formula
Atlantic in Chevron cars85 Races.
- 1997-1999 Historic races in USA, in Formula 2, Sports /Prototype and Lola T400 Formula 5000.....36 Races.
- 1999- **Started his own Historic Racing Organization in California "HSR-West"** and after 13 years
with a total of 98 events organized, sold it in December 2012 to Tony Parella to merge into SVRA.

- 2012-2016 Historic races in USA and Australia with Can-Am, F2 and Sports racers..... 46 Races

Driven in 51 different car types on 87 race tracks in 20 countries.
